- The minutes of the July 25, 2019, meeting were reviewed. No corrections were identified at this time, but due to lack of a quorum, the vote for approval was tabled until the next meeting.
- Steven Crawford has not attended any meetings since his interview for membership at the July 2018 meeting. Asheia Green made a motion to consider removal of Steven Crawford from membership on the Goochland-Powhatan Local Human Rights Committee for failure to participate in the committee. The vote on the matter was tabled due to lack of a quorum and will be placed on the January 2020 agenda as old business.
- This committee is still in need of a consumer representative and will now need to recruit another healthcare professional. Asheia Green offered to change her representation to consumer, leaving only a healthcare professional needed.
