Norton discussed internal review over 8 months with an intent to roll out to the public. Pappas spoke to the impact and success of ORS within the professional peer community • Corbin asked how this will impact child and family services. Norton does not anticipate any functional changes to communications and implementation. Aletheia will remain the primary contact for the peer recovery community and Colleen will be for the prevention community. Norton acknowledges that most of the work of the department is cross-disability and cooccurring disorders. Reporting structure is changing but operating structure is more project-based and cross-departmental Conversation around peer representation in legislative work groups, particularly DBHDS peer subject matter experts Bently Wood spoke to the history of othering peers and that this was proliferated potentially through not including the peer community in this decision process and that this may have caused the resistance and feedback the DBHDS is experiencing.

		 Heather Pate acknowledged the potential that this could streamline prior contract concerns but spoke to concerns around the process to make this change, the information rollout, and the continued positive impact of ORS' relationship-building work. Norton noted she is available to represent and field questions and concerns.
